Dorset Cereals

Problem:

Dorset Cereals needed to resolve a waste-handling problem. Their existing equipment was not providing a satisfactory solution.

Solution:

The various problems required different solutions:

- A **Mil-tek** 306 Baler was installed to deal with polythene waste.
- **Mil-tek** Plastic Bag Stands were placed at various points on the production floor to collect loose plastic waste. These bags are subsequently baled for recycling.
- A **Mil-tek** X-Press 100 was installed to deal with general process waste. Extra wagons, used to collect waste, were placed at strategic points on the production floor.

Additional Benefits:

- Waste is now well managed and the production floor is much tidier.
- Productivity has improved.
- Waste plastic and cardboard is now sold for recycling – providing an additional revenue stream.
- Dorset Cereals has recently achieved the EFSIS (*European Food Safety Inspection Service*) Higher Level Approval Certificate – essential when dealing with household name retailers. The existence of an effective waste handling strategy was an important part of this approval.
